Part 1:

For part I of this assessment, you will develop the fiscal policies, procedures and projected budget for your center/ organization. All policies and procedures should represent best practice as well as state, federal and local mandates as well as sound fiscal management principals. Your policies and procedures should include but not be limited to:

- Revenue
 - Tuition (including daily, ½ day, hourly rates and sliding scale parameters)
 - Fess (including registration, diaper, late, late payment, vacation etc.)
 - Bookkeeping system and tuition collection policies for assessing, billing and collecting fees and tuition
- Expenses
 - Annual estimated budget
 - Salaries
 - Benefits
 - Equipment upgrades, depreciation, & repair
 - Supplies
 - Materials
 - Food service
 - Parent training
 - Staff training and professional development
 - Excursions and special activities
 - Ongoing recruitment/marketing
 - Telephone
 - Postage
 - Printing
 - Uncollected fees

Part 2:

For Part 2, you will develop the startup budget for your center/organization including but not limited to:

- Building/ space rent/purchase/ or build
- Equipment
- Materials
- Supplies
- Printing/communication/marketing
- Postage
- Phone
- Utilities
- Staff payroll/ benefits (salary scale, pay dates, sick and personal leave, insurance/benefits, vacation)
- New staff orientation and training
- Licensing/certification fees
