Goal 1: Support implementation of all Gateways Credentials within state systems

- 1. Objective 1: Support the ESL and Bilingual Credential through the final review and credential recommendation approval process. NEARLY COMPLETE!
 - ESL & Bilingual Credential rec. passed by QC 10/21/21. Signed by IDHS 2/2/22.
 - ESL & Bilingual Credential Career Lattice rec. 11/29/22. Steering approved 2/1/23. Pending PDAC & IDHS approval.
- 2. **Objective 2:** Survey existing utilization of credentials, align credentials within the existing qualifications in cross-sector systems, and expand credential usage in cross-section systems when feasible.
 - Revisit DCFS/Credential Crosswalk recommendation to embed Credentials as an option to meet DCFS requirements.

Goal 2: Promote and incentivize mechanisms that advance incremental steps to increase attainment of Gateways Credentials at all levels.

- 1. Objective 1: Encourage a dashboard of progress within the Gateways Registry Professional Development Record toward competency completion for each credential.
 - Ongoing discussions with Joellyn Whitehead.

- 4. Objective 4: Increase participation in the credentialing system. COMPLETE!
 - Barrier: Cost/Fee Rec. approved by IDHS 7/1/22.

Goal 3: Identify how Relationship Based Professional Development (RBPD) can support competency attainment and achievement of Gateways Credentials.

- 1. Objective 1: Investigate and expand the utilization of RBPD within cross-sector Professional Development Systems.
 - Job Embedded Professional Development: McCormick IDC competency pilot
- 2. Objective 2: Research innovative strategies supporting Prior Learning Assessment credit (Higher Education Committee) including Relationship Based Professional Development (RBPD) efforts to support students and practitioners in gaining college credit.
 - RBPD/Job Embedded Professional Development pilot potential joint recommendation with the Higher Education Committee?

Goal 4: Ensure Gateways to Opportunity Credentials align with state and national initiatives, incorporate current research and validated practices, and are responsive to workforce needs.

- 3. Objective 3: Enrich Gateways Credential review processes by incorporating diversity, equity, and inclusion lens. ECE/ITC COMPLETE
- 4. **Objective 4:** Deepen knowledge of credentials and non-credentialed workforce through data collection focused on current and emerging demographics and ongoing inequities.
